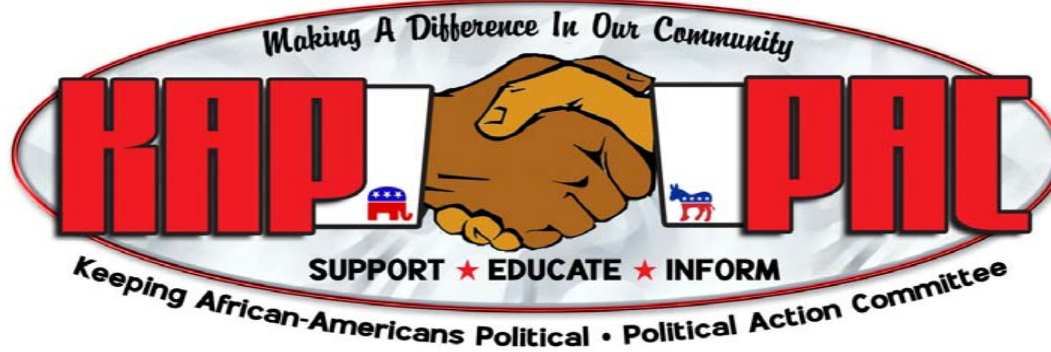

# 2008 KAPPAC GOALS

*\$600,000*

- 50% of members @ \$120 = \$600K or
  - 10 Charter @ \$5K Level in each Province = \$600K
  - 10 Charter @ \$1K Level in each Province = \$120K
  - 20 Regional @ \$500 Level in each Province = \$120K
  - 100 @ \$120 Alumni Level in each Province = \$144K
  - 12 Province KAPPAC Fundraisers \$25K each = \$300K
